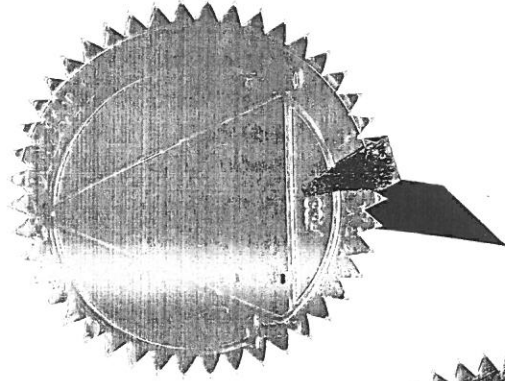

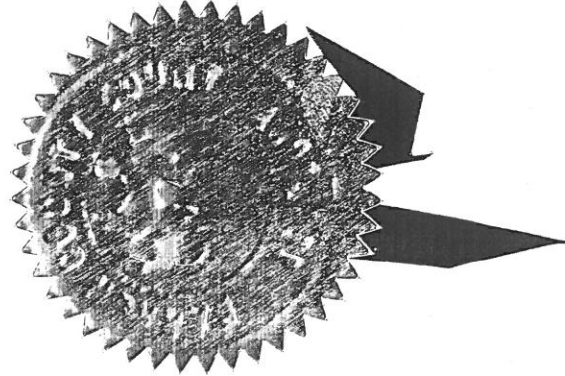
#### “NATIONAL CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH”
