NATIONAL DONATE LIFE MONTH
APRIL 2018**

Whereas: The Kentucky Circuit Clerks' Trust For Life is a statewide non-profit organization that informs, educates, and encourages Kentuckians to be registered organ, tissue, and cornea donors to save lives; and,

Whereas: Nationally, over 118,000 people are currently on the national waiting list for a lifesaving transplant; and,

Whereas: Approximately 1,000 of those on the waiting list live in the Commonwealth of Kentucky; and many of those people reside in our community; and,

Whereas: Kentucky has 144 driver's license offices with dedicated and hardworking clerks ask every customer, every day to join the Kentucky Organ Donor Registry and donate \$1 to increase public education about this mission; and,

Whereas: The Barren Circuit Clerk's Office is dedicated to the mission of saving lives, and recognizes organ donation and transplantation as a life saving measure; and,

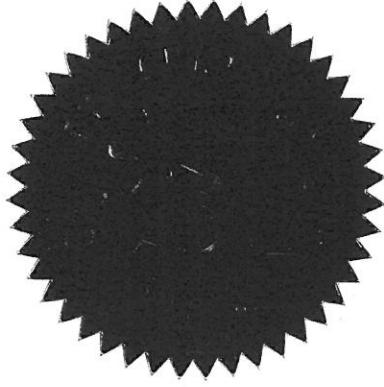
Whereas: Sharing the Gift of Life - the decision to donate organs, is an issue that we are all called to consider at the end of our lives; and,

Whereas: The educational outreach and efforts of our community leaders, medical professionals, Circuit Court Clerk, and mentors will only provide a positive impact on the lives of those who wait for this life saving gift of organ or tissue transplantation; and

Whereas: Because of the questions at the Circuit Clerk's office, more than 1.7 million Kentuckians have registered as organ, tissue, and cornea donors.

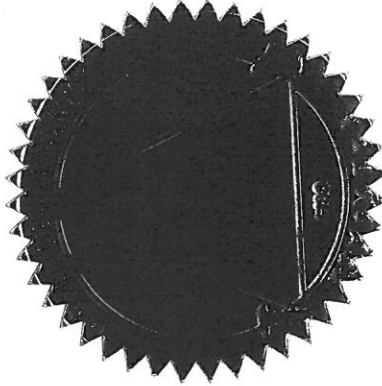
