appointment with the citizen, he had several people that had called and said that they would serve

on boards, some wanted specific boards, Mr. Biggers said that he would like to serve on the EPB Board or the Water Company Board or a couple of others that he couldn't remember. Mayor Armstrong indicated that he had a bio for Mr. Biggers. Mayor Armstrong gave a quick overview of that bio. Mr. Biggers is a teacher here at the school, an instructor on the college level, has a PHD, and Mayor Armstrong thinks that he is qualified to listen to all the items that would come before the board. Mayor Armstrong wanted to also point out he wanted to thank Cheryl Ambach for serving on the EPB for eight (8) years. Mayor Armstrong said that he was of the opinion that each person on a board for about four (4) years and can tolerate all of the problems that you occur,

she has done a good service for Glasgow. Mayor Armstrong said that if four (4) years from now if he was still in the Mayor's position, that he'll probably be putting someone else on there to replace Mr. Biggers. He expressed that was only his opinion and anyone was welcome to read Mr. Biggers bio.

Council Member Norris said that he had learned a lot from serving on that committee and he appreciated the help that he got while serving.

Council Member Gaunce asked Mayor Armstrong if Cheryl wanted off or was that the Mayor's choice. The Mayor responded with that he didn't even talk to her that a close friend of hers told him that she was fed up. He hadn't heard anything else until it come out in the paper that she was willing to serve again. Gaunce asked if that would have made a difference in his selection if he knew that she wanted to serve again. Mayor said he would have taken it into consideration after she's been on there for four years and he thinks that she's been a great board member. Gaunce

said that he didn't have an issue with Mark Biggers as a person or as a teacher, but he did have a problem with him being one of the thirty-six people that was in a "hateful group" that spewed a lot of venom. Mayor Armstrong then told Gaunce to vote against him.

Council Member Norris wanted to verify that the ordinance “as is” failed, but that it could go back to the Recreation Department. Mayor Armstrong confirmed that it would go back in effect for it to go back to the Recreation Department and the Finance Committee to come up with a plan to do work on the Parks. Mayor Armstrong also stated this is no reflection on the Parks employees, as this has been on-going for probably 15-18 years on the neglect on what should have been being spent. This group is committed to getting the parks fixed and much work will be done to get the parks fixed up.

Council Member Gaunce asked if we would still be using them (Brandstetter and Carol) for their work. Mayor Armstrong said that we would be taking the survey that they’ve got and put it with some independent local people that have done some surveys and take both to the Parks, along with Eddie Furlong, and let him review. He will look and see if there is extra stuff that needs to go, that was overlooked. We will then start getting bids and go from there.
