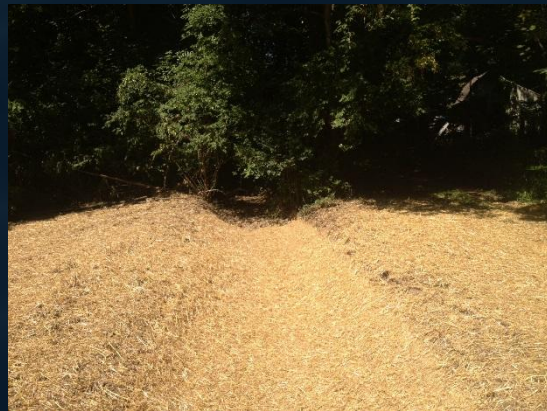

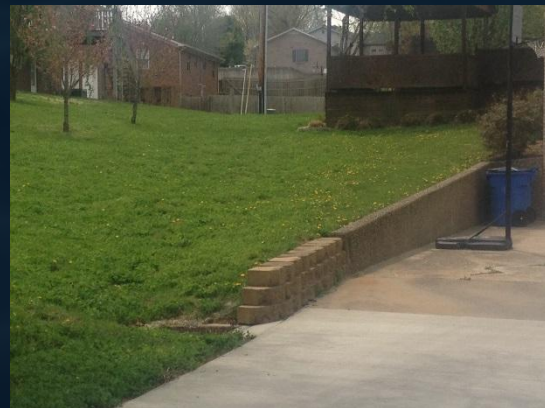

# Master Plan

**In-House Projects:** Projects that will have a clear solution that needs little evaluation or refinement for the City to be able to construct.

**Capital Projects:** Projects that may have multiple alternatives, each of which needs to be preliminarily evaluated. Each will need further refinement during final design before any construction can take place.

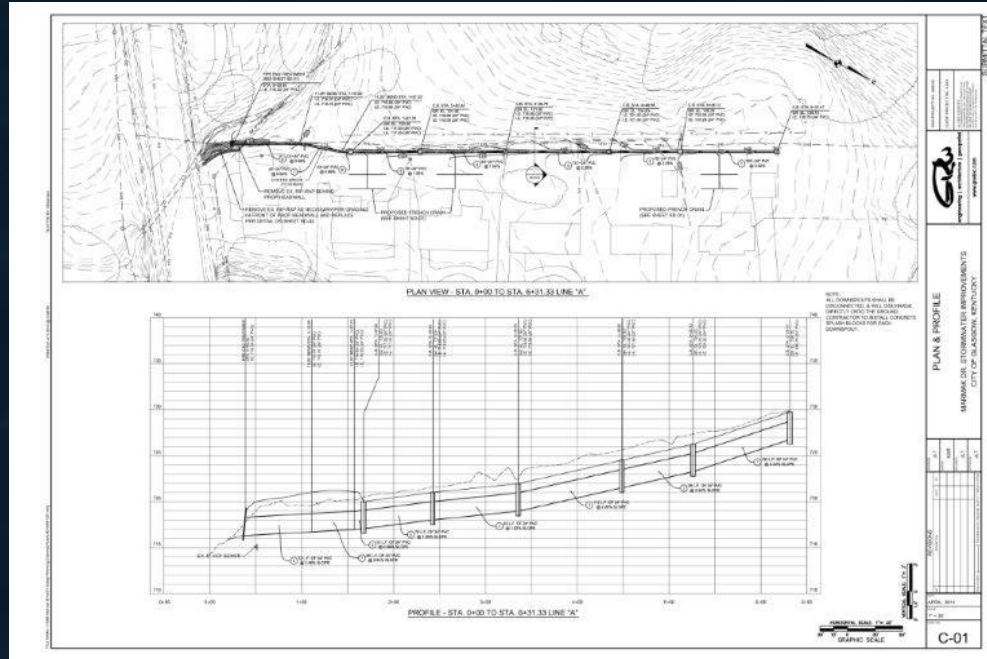

## Construction Site Permitting & Inspection

- All projects over 1 acre
- Land Disturbance Permit
- Maintenance Agreement (if permanent on-site drainage structure)
- City must inspect to ensure site stays in compliance with Local, State and Federal regulations.
