AGING & DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER (ADRC): Provides citizens with information, assistance, and resources related to services & support for individuals who are 60 years of age or older and/or disabled individuals.

ADULT DAY HEALTH CARE: A center providing a safe structured environment for persons needing supervision due to poor health and/or mental confusion.

OMBUDSMAN: A program designed to receive, investigate, resolve & report complaints on behalf of residents in long-term care facilities.

LEGAL SERVICES: This program provides legal assistance, consultation & representation to seniors & disabled individuals.

SHIP (STATE HEALTH INSURANCE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM):

Benefits Counseling providing older and/or disabled individuals one-on-one assistance with questions regarding Social Security, SSI, Medicare, Medicare Advantage, Medicare Part D, Medicaid & other public & private benefits.

COMMUNITY ACTION SENIOR CENTERS: Transportation, Outreach, Information & Assistance, Health Promotion, Telephone Reassurance, Nutrition Education, Congregate & Home Delivered Meals (delivered to eligible persons 60 years or over who are homebound because of an illness or disability with no support available to help prepare a nutritious meal). are all services offered by the senior centers specifically designed for seniors. In addition to these services,

the senior centers provide socialization, recreation, exercise, arts, crafts, education classes, and an overall enjoyable place to participate.

In-Home Services: For in-home services, a case manager will perform an in-home assessment. This assessment is an in-depth collection of information of the client's current situation and function. Based on this assessment, a comprehensive plan of care will be developed to meet the client's needs. The case manager will determine services that the client is eligible for and maintain client contact to ensure that appropriate, comprehensive, and timely services are received.

HOME MANAGEMENT: Housekeeping services to aid a person in activities of daily living such as cleaning, shopping & laundry.

PERSONAL CARE: Services to aid the client in personal care activities such as bathing, dressing & hair care.

RESPIRE: Limited in-home services to provide relief for a caregiver.

PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANT PROGRAM: Provides personal care attendant service for mentally alert, severely physically disabled adults 18 years of age and older.

ESCORT: Personal accompaniment of a frail elderly person who requires assistance to & from a medical appointment.

MEDICAID WAIVER PROGRAM: Provides eligible Medicaid Waiver participants greater choices in selecting care providers for in-home & community services. This program provides a person-centered plan of care development & case management services.

Family Caregiver Support Services: Assists

Caregivers and grandparents raising grandchildren by providing information about available resources, assistance in gaining access to services, counseling, support groups, training, respite & supplemental services.

Barren River Long Term Care Ombudsman Program (BRLTCOP)

Provides education services to residents, families, staff & community partners, BRLTCOP advocates for residents in nursing homes & personal care homes in the BRADD area. BRLTCOP advocates to ensure residents rights are not being violated, state and federal regulations are being followed & appropriate care is being provide to ensure quality of care and quality of life.
