What can I recycle?

Newspapers

Glass Bottles & Jars (no window panes, light bulbs, drinking glasses or other glass)

- Remove lid
- Rinse jars/bottles
- Do not remove labels

Aluminum Beverage Cans (no foil, pie tins, or dinner roll tins)

- Rinse cans
- Flatten to save space



Cardboard

- Flattened
- Telephone books and catalogues are also accepted

Tin Cans

- Rinse cans. Please do not remove labels

Plastic

- #1 Clear and Green (drink bottles)
- #2 Plastic Milk Jugs
- Laundry Detergent Jugs

PLEASE SORT ALL RECYCLABLES- this speeds up the process.
NO HOUSEHOLD TRASH ACCEPTED

How do I recycle?

Curbside recycling is available to city residents and is collected on the scheduled trash pick-up day. If your residence has dumpsters, you can take your items to the landfill at no charge. The first Saturday of each month, recycling is available at DPW Parking Lot (310 W. Front St.) All residents are encouraged to reduce, reuse, and recycle! Please request a bin for curbside service!
